DECLARATION (REQUIRED FOR ALL DANGEROUS GOODS)

"It is certified that the goods are packed and stowed in accordance with the Merchant Shipping (Dangerous Goods) Rules 1965, as amended 1968, and the recommendations of the 1966 report of the Department of Trade and Industry's Standing Advisory Committee on the Carriage of Dangerous Goods in Ships (The Blue Book), as amended, in particular the recommendations for Tropical Voyages, and are packed and stowed in a manner adequate to withstand the ordinary risks of handling and transport having regard to the nature of the goods.

- 3 All packages have been inspected for damage and only dry, sound packages loaded.
- 4 All packages have been properly stowed and secured and suitable securing materials used.
- 5 The container and goods are properly labelled.
- 6 The dangerous goods in this container are those accepted under the above Booking Reference Number(s).
